COVID-19 Protocols for Basketball Season

Crescent Public Schools has developed a policy for the upcoming season in which we hope will allow everyone to enjoy the 2020-2021 basketball season. We believe that these safety measures will protect our players, officials, and spectators who wish to attend a ballgame here in Crescent. We ask for your patience and understanding as we must all work together to ensure the safety of everyone in attendance while allowing our student/athletes the best chance to start and complete their upcoming season.

For the safety of everyone in attendance, we ask that anyone feeling ill, running a fever or having symptoms associated with the COVID-19 virus to NOT attend the games.

General guidelines:

- Seating capacity will be limited due to Governor Stitt's executive order pertaining to indoor activities.
- Each team member will be allocated 4 player passes for home games.
- In order to have the right to purchase a ticket to enter the game, you must possess a player pass.
- We ask that each person entering the building maintain all CDC recommendations concerning social distancing
- Masks are recommended but NOT required at this time.
- The first row behind both of the team benches will be unavailable for spectator seating.
- We ask that all spectators to please limit their time in the lobby.
- The restrooms and concession stand will be open to spectators. Please follow all social distancing and CDC recommendations concerning the COVID-19 virus.

We appreciate your understanding of our safety measures and we will continue to monitor and evaluate the current COVID-19 situation and make adjustments we deem necessary to ensure the safety of all who attend ballgames in Crescent during the 2020-2021 school year.
