Parents and Guardians:

The Oklahoma State Department of Education has released the Oklahoma State Testing Portal, which is designed to provide students and parents with online access to a student's state assessment scores. It is important to create an online account now, as paper reports will not be printed next year.

In addition to providing online access to a child's state testing results, the portal also will assist parents and guardians with tracking assessment information throughout the student's academic career. The portal provides scores from the OSTP 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 assessments. Assessments will be added to the portal each year.

  - To view your child's scores, you will need their date of birth and their STN (Student Testing Number). It is available on the paper copy of the score report mentioned above.
